**THURSDAY SNOWBOARDING
TUESDAY & THURSDAY SKIING**

**4-6 YEAR OLD INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM
ONE HOUR EVERY TUESDAY FOR 7 WEEKS**

Minimum number of students must be enrolled for this class to be held. Parent/guardian must be present at each session. Tiny Tots is designed for children who have not skied before and Tiny Tots Plus is for children who have skied before.

8-WEEK SKI PROGRAM

Meeting one or two nights per week. All ability levels.

10-WEEK SKI PROGRAM

Meeting 2-3 times per week. Race programs include two main sessions per week and one optional session per week. Tuesday and Thursday nights at Schuss, and now Saturday nights at Schuss.

7-WEEK "CARVING" SNOWBOARD PROGRAM

Meeting ONCE per week on Thursdays. This program will not teach any jumps or tricks. Beginner and intermediate only. First time snowboarders must be at least 8 years old.

Student(s) must be enrolled in clinic(s) for them and/or their parent/guardian to purchase season passes. They must attend clinics to retain their passes. Clinic prices do not include lift tickets or passes.

Beginner racers are welcome to register in all race clinics. Tiny Tots Plus and Tiny Tots are 1 Hour Lessons. All other lessons are an hour and a half. All lessons start at 6pm, except Saturday race, which is at 4:30pm.
