Entry Fee:

\$450 per club - \$275 for clubs with less than 20 racers + \$10.00 per racer (includes a commemorative shirt) - Team entry fees and completed release forms are due to NMSA when club packets are distributed the morning of the race. Individual racer entry fees will be paid directly to the NMSA team (Checks made out to Boyne Highlands) to obtain the commemorative shirts.

Race Bibs:

A set of race bibs/numbers will be assigned to each club for their racers. The club is responsible to collect their bibs following the race and turn them into NMSA. Clubs will be charged \$25.00 for each bib that is not turned in on race day.
